



Coronavirus update- possible disruption to service

We are very sad to inform you that Bova UK has had a number of positive Coronavirus tests come back over the weekend, within our production and head office team. Currently, we have more than 25 staff either tested positive or self-isolating due to close contact. At Bova UK we have been working in line with government guidance and divided our staff teams accordingly. With a number of staff now self-isolating it is possible that our production and distribution capacity may be temporarily reduced.

Please be reassured that we will make every effort to fulfill orders to our usual timelines. We would ask for your understanding if there are delays, whilst we ensure we continue to take all possible measures to protect the health of our team. The staff that are not self-isolating will be working extra hours to fill any gaps. We are already working 7-days per week to maintain supplies whilst ensuring the safety of the working environment. We are working as hard as possible to provide continuity of supply and ask you to only place orders for formulations on a need only basis and do not panic buy or place unnecessarily large orders, given the strain on our production team, as we would like to continue to provide a service to as many clinics as possible in this difficult time.

We will continue to keep you updated as the situation unfolds at Bova UK. Please know that we are doing everything we can to protect our staff and maintain the supply of your medications.
